- Also aerobatic (loops, rolls, stall turns, spins, Immelman, cloverleaf,...)
- Finances
 - £4,000 buy-in; you are then a part-owner. Refunded fully when leaving (2 months notice this gives time to advertise for new member)
 - £145 per month. This covers all overheads (hangarage, insurance, scheduled maintenance, even unscheduled maintenance). Think of it as "insurance" against ever having to get your chequebook out; sleep easy at night. Big unexpected bills are not your problem.
 - £110 per hour, based on Tacho hours. This is the fairest system. On a typical 1 hour flight, the tacho time will be less than the block time that you log, so the actual hourly rate is less than £110 ph.
